Certification requirements

Passport or other primary identity documents:

Instructions for the candidate

The certifying official must see and photocopy the original identity document, and then certify the photocopy. Print pages 2 and 3 to bring to the certifying official. It is **your responsibility** to ensure that your documents are properly certified according to these requirements.

It is important that candidates verify ahead of time that the certifying official has:

- The mandate and offers certification services in ENGLISH or FRENCH
- An ENGLISH or FRENCH seal or stamp

Note:

- · Improper certification will result in delays
- · Candidates must NOT certify their own documents
- · Candidates are responsible for the costs of certification
- · The MCC does not require copies of your medical credentials to be certified

Certifications done online, virtually, digitally or electronically are not acceptable.

Acceptable certifying officials

The Medical Council of Canada (MCC) accepts certification from the officials below if it is within their mandate and they offer these services.

In any country

- Authorized representatives at the Dean or at the Registrar offices of the candidate's faculty (school) of medicine
- Notary public
- · Lawyers (member of an official bar association)
- · First-class magistrates, judges/justices of the peace
- Officials at some embassies or consulate (if it is a service that they provide)

In the United States only

- An official listed as acceptable in any country (above), as well as:
 - Commissioner of oaths (provided that they have an official government agency appointment and an ENGLISH or FRENCH seal or stamp)

In Canada only

- An official listed as acceptable in any country (above), as well as:
 - Commissioner of oaths (provided that they have an official government agency appointment and an ENGLISH or FRENCH seal or stamp)
 - Mayor
 - Police officer (municipal, provincial or RCMP; contact information must include badge number and headquarter location)



Instructions for the certifying official

Passport or other primary identity documents

AS THE CERTIFYING OFFICIAL, YOU:

- MUST see and photocopy the passport or other original identity documents, and certify the photocopies
- · Are asked to attest to having seen the original document, not to certify the authenticity or the content of a document
- 1. The **certifying official** must photocopy the originals and ensure:
 - 1.1 That the **DOCUMENT's BORDERS**, sum dolor sit amet, consetetur sadipscii TEXT (including signatures), and IMAGES irmod tempor invidunt ut labore et dol tempor diam voluptua. At vero eos et accusam are legible and clear. bum. Stet clita kasd gubergren, no sea tal Lorem ipsum dolor sit amet.
- 2. The **certifying official** must include the following on each page:
 - 2.1 The certifying official MUST include their Certifying Official, Notary Public name and title. 123 Any Street, City, Country 2.2 The certifying official MUST include their certifyingofficial@server.com contact information (address, phone tel.: 613-555-5555 number and email). 2.3 The certifying official MUST apply their **OR ENGLISH or FRENCH** embossed seal **PROVINCE** or ink stamp. 2.4 The certifying official MUST DECLARE and WRITE in "I certify this to be a true copy **EITHER** English: of the original." « Je certifie que la présente est **OR** French: une copie conforme à l'original. » 2.5 The certifying official MUST DATE Month 1, 2024 the certification.
